



ACA AWARDS

Description of Qualifications

Airport of the Year: This award is given to a Public-Use Airport located in the state of Alabama. The airport should show outstanding efforts in such categories as serving the public, maintaining their facilities, Economic Development, etc.

Eligibility

Candidates must be a current member of The Aviation Council of Alabama for 3 years and in good standing.

Airport Manager of the Year: This award is given to the Airport Manager of a Public-Use Airport located in the state of Alabama. Though it is often given in association with the Airport of the Year Award since a successful airport is usually dependent on its manager for a significant amount of its support and success, there have been occasions when a manager has shown exemplary activity. This includes but is not limited to administration, engineering, planning, environmental, operations, maintenance, and emergency response type functions.

Eligibility

Candidates must be a current member of The Aviation Council of Alabama for two years and in good standing.

Aviation Professional of the Year Award: The Aviation Professional of the Year Award recognizes individuals who are not currently exercising active responsibility for the management, general supervision, or administration of a public-use airport who have devoted their skills, talent, personal resources, time, or alliances in the betterment of airports or aviation in its entirety.

Eligibility

Corporate Champion: The "Corporate Champion" is awarded to a Corporation who has demonstrated outstanding visionary, innovative, and strategic thinking through its contributions toward the advancement of the airport and aviation industry as well the goals and objectives of its clients. The award recognizes the outstanding dedication, contributions and/or service to The Aviation Council of Alabama and/or the airport system of Alabama.

Eligibility

Candidates must be a current member of The Aviation Council of Alabama for two years and in good standing.

Requirements:

- Memberships must be in good standing.
- Applicants **must submit** a cover letter and supporting documentation as to why you should be selected for the award you are applying for.
- Applications must be received by 5PM on June 1st.
